Families can pay for gift cards with credit cards. Today's the day. In addition to linking a bank account (PrestoPay[™]), families now have the option to pay for gift cards with credit cards. Important details about this new payment option:

CREDIT CARD TYPES

Visa and Mastercard are accepted.

Rebates:

The rebate is not impacted—families, and your organization, still earn the same amount. Your organization's earnings are credited the same way as linked bank account payments. Purchases: A 2.6% fee is added to a family's order total each time they pay with a credit card. Your organization does not pay a fee. Credit card payments are processed immediately. As a reminder, credit card payments are only available to families who can pay online. Those families will automatically have the option to choose "Credit Card" under "Payment Options" in their cart.
